When I sat down after the service, the pastor of the church pointed at me from behind the pulpit and everyone else started to look at me. Some of the people began to raise their hands and then the pastor starts texting while he was still behind the pulpit, he sent me a message saying "We're taking you on for support!" I was thrilled! Praise the Lord!

A new (to us) car!

In the middle of September, we found out that our 2012 silver Kia Soul was burning oil at about 150,000 miles. This can lead to a host of problems that will be costly to repair, and to take apart the engine to replace the piston rings will cost two to three times more than the car is worth. In God's provision, a relative of ours decided to give us her 2012 green Kia Soul with 110,000 miles on it, free of charge! We truly thank God for this since it will be impossible for us to get another car loan at this point with only about 25% support after quitting both of our jobs earlier this year.
